

Sham-Roxz Volleyball Parent/Player Code of Conduct

Playing Time: It is earned and at the discretion of the Coach; it is reasonable to speculate that playing time may be distributed more liberally at the lower levels.

Viewing practices: Parents are always welcome. They must remember that they are there for support. Let the Coach coach and the athletes practice.

Attending Matches: Impromptu conferences with Coaches are discouraged; spectators are encouraged to remain positive and supportive towards opponents, players, Coaches and referees; players will communicate to the Coach, well in advance, concerning any missed practices, tournaments or conflicts.

Payment: Players whose account is delinquent will be withheld from practice and tournaments.

Attendance: Attendance is key to progress. Match play is solely up to the discretion of the head Coach, play time will be affected by unexcused attendance.

Multi-Sport Athletes: Players on all teams will be expected to attend all practices unless cleared by the Head Coach. Each situation will be handled individually.

Event Behavior: Players will support other Sham-Roxz teams participating in an event; no players will leave the event until the entire team is dismissed after the last match or officiating duty.

Travel Behavior: Players are representing the Sham-Roxz Volleyball Club and will act appropriately in hotels and playing venues. Players will avoid any conduct that is illegal or immoral; will abide by curfew times, rules set by the Coach and attend all team meetings and functions. Parents will be contacted and involved if these rules are not followed and possible dismissal from the event.

Sham-Roxz Volleyball Club will adhere to the code of Conduct required by the Florida Region of USAV. Players agreed to abide by this as part of the registration with USAV.
